Virginia Water Supply Revolving Fund, Project # BIL 018S-23

The Town of Blackstone has applied for funding from the Virginia Water Supply Revolving Fund—which administers funding through the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law—for its Nottoway River Reservoir Aeration System Replacement Project. The project proposes the replacement of aeration lines and diffuser lines within the Nottoway Reservoir, an air compressor with two air compressors for redundancy, an air receiver tank, a two-stage filter system, an oil/water separator, and air flow meters. Proposed replacement of aeration and diffuser lines will be within the Nottoway Reservoir; other replacements will be within fenced, previously disturbed areas at a pump station on Brunswick Road. Best Management Practices would be implemented to minimize impacts, and all federal, state, and local ordinances will be followed. The total funding request for the project is \$567,000. A description of the project and an Environmental Assessment of the project are on file at the Blackstone Town Manager's Office, 100 W. Elm Street, Blackstone, Va. and available for public review between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday except designated holidays.
