

Notice of Public Hearing

Town of Blackstone

Notice is hereby given that on July 18, 2022 the Town Council of Blackstone, Virginia (the “Town”) will conduct a public hearing, which may be continued or adjourned, as required under applicable law, in accordance with Section 15.2-2606 of the Code of Virginia of 1950, as amended, with respect to the adoption by the Council of a resolution or resolutions, as may be necessary or convenient, regarding the proposed financing of all or a portion of the costs of certain water and sewer system infrastructure improvements, including the upgrades, rehabilitation and equipping of the Water Treatment Plant; the construction, upgrades and replacement of East End Utilities, Phase II; and refinancing of the East End Utilities, Phase I, together with related administrative and financing costs and expenses (the “Project”). The Town proposes to fund the project in part by the issuance of a bond or bonds to be issued in a principal amount not to exceed \$3,200,000, secured by revenues of the water and sewer system of the Town. The purpose of the financing is to pay for the costs of the Project described above.

The public hearing, which may be continued or adjourned, will be conducted at 7:00PM or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, by the Town Council in Council Chambers at the Town Hall located at 100 W. Elm Street, Blackstone, Virginia. Interested persons may appear at such time and place and present their views whether orally or in writing or submit written comments prior to the hearing.
