

## Town of Blackstone, Virginia

### Notice of Public Hearing

Notice is hereby given that on April 21, 2025 the Town Council of Blackstone, Virginia (the “Town”) will conduct a public hearing, which may be continued or adjourned, as required under applicable law, in accordance with Section 15.2-2606 of the Code of Virginia of 1950, as amended, with respect to the adoption by the Council of a resolution or resolutions, as may be necessary or convenient, regarding the proposed financing of all or a portion of the costs of certain water and sewer system infrastructure improvements, including emergency repairs to sewer lines, the replacement, rehabilitation and site work for installing and connecting sewer lines, together with related administrative, engineering and financing costs and expenses (the “Project”). The Town proposes to fund the project in part by the issuance of a bond or bonds to be issued in a principal amount not to exceed \$6,000,000, secured by revenues of the water and sewer system of the Town. The purpose of the financing is to pay for the costs of the Project described above.

The public hearing, which may be continued or adjourned, will be conducted at 7:00PM or as soon thereafter as they matter may be heard, by the Town Council in Council Chambers at the Town Hall located at 100 W. Elm Street, Blackstone, Virginia. Interested persons may appear at such time and place and present their views whether orally or in writing or submit written comments prior to the hearing. The Town may set time limits on speakers and other rules and procedures for the conduct of this public hearing. To be published two times – on April 2, 2025 and April 9, 2025 (i.e. one week apart with the second notice to be at least 6 days prior to the public hearing. n.b. The hearing must take place with at least 7 days of the second notice of the public hearing.)
